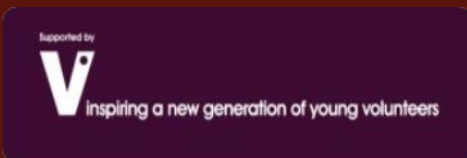
Shain Uddin has been awarded the Jack Petchey Achievement Award for **March 2011** because of his hard work in training and games.
